CHIEF EXECUTIVE STEPS DOWN

The current Kimberley Ports Authority CEO Craig Faulkner is leaving to take on a new position with the Port of Melbourne as Executive General Manager, Operations effective from 10th June 2022.

“It is with regret that the KPA Board accepts Craig’s resignation after two years and nine months with the Authority,” stated Reece Waldock KPA’s Chair. “During his time with us Craig has been instrumental in returning KPA to a stable financial position, amalgamating the other three commercial Kimberley ports into KPA as well as progressing potential major infrastructure projects in the region.”

“We wish Craig and his partner Gina all the best in their future endeavours,” declared Mr Waldock.

“The Board has appointed the current KPA Chief Operating Officer, Luke Westlake as the Acting CEO until a permanent appointment is made,” Mr Waldock said.

Luke has spent most of his career in the Australian ports industry and has held a variety of management roles in stevedoring and towage for DP World, Asciano and TK Shipping.

Prior to joining KPA Luke was General Manager Operations and Director of DP World Fremantle.
