Please be advised that from 31 March 2020 all vessels, recreational and commercial:-

Greater than 15m LOA or

Greater than 150 GRT or

Capable of Carrying 6 or more Passengers


MUST report all entry and departures into or out of the Port of Broome waters, and MUST report all movements within the Port waters to Port Operations on Channel 14 and or 16.
