This Marine Notice supersedes LMN 11-2025 – dated 17th June 2025.

Mariners and Port Users are advised of the following works within the Port of Broome:

A revised exclusion zone will remain established for the duration of the planned works, to provide a safe area for the activities to be undertaken.

- Installation of the floating pontoon is planned to commence from the 19th of July, with completion expected by end of July 2025.
- During this period, there will be an increased presence of support vessels, including tugs and workboats, operating within the area. In the initial stages of the installation, support tugs will be actively engaged in holding the pontoon in position, which may result in propeller wash and turbulence in the immediate vicinity of the works.
- Shipping schedule may be adjusted during these dates to minimise any adverse impacts to port users, while supporting the timely progress of these critical works as part of the port development project.

All Commercial and Recreational users are advised to navigate with caution while operating near the exclusion zone and not to enter the zone.















Chartlet showing the KMSB Construction Exclusion Zone
