Since 1889 the Port of Broome has supported Western Australia's North West livestock exports, offshore oil and gas activities, pearling, fishing and charter boat work, cruise liner tourism and government vessel visits.

Broome is the main break bulk, fuel and container terminal for the Kimberley and is a support base for the offshore Browse Basin.

In accordance with section 14A of the Port Authorities Act 1999 Kimberley Ports Authority (KPA) seeks nominations to fill two positions on the Community Consultation Committee (**CCC**).
